### FUEL SURCHARGE

Due to the volatile nature of the fuel market, it may be necessary to implement a fuel surcharge. We base the fuel surcharge on the Los Angeles Index for Kerosene-Type Jet Fuel Price that is reported by the US Department of Energy ([http://www.eia.doe.gov/pub/oil\\_gas/petroleum/data\\_publications/weekly\\_petroleum\\_status\\_report/current/pdf/table15.pdf](http://www.eia.doe.gov/pub/oil_gas/petroleum/data_publications/weekly_petroleum_status_report/current/pdf/table15.pdf)). A Fuel Surcharge will be added for increases in the base fuel prices as of Dec. 31 of the previous year. A \$4.25 addition to each heli hour per person will be added for each percentage (%) increase.

## ARRIVAL

Upon arrival at Anchorage International Airport, you will be taking one of our shuttles. If you would prefer a private shuttle, you can hire a taxi at the airport or call the Millennium Hotel Shuttle at (907)243-2300. After collecting your luggage, you will meet your CPG host (or other transport) who will arrange for you to be taken to the Millennium Hotel, a quick 5 minute drive from the Airport. Prior to your arrival we will need your travel information, including the preferred shuttle time, so we know what terminal to pick you up at, and how many people will be on each shuttle.

You may want to have this schedule with you when making airline reservations. Try to get flights that arrive/depart around these shuttle times. Please choose a time that works best for your arrival, and departure times. Once arrangements are made please choose both arrival and departure shuttle numbers from below. Please enter these numbers in the travel arrangement section below.
